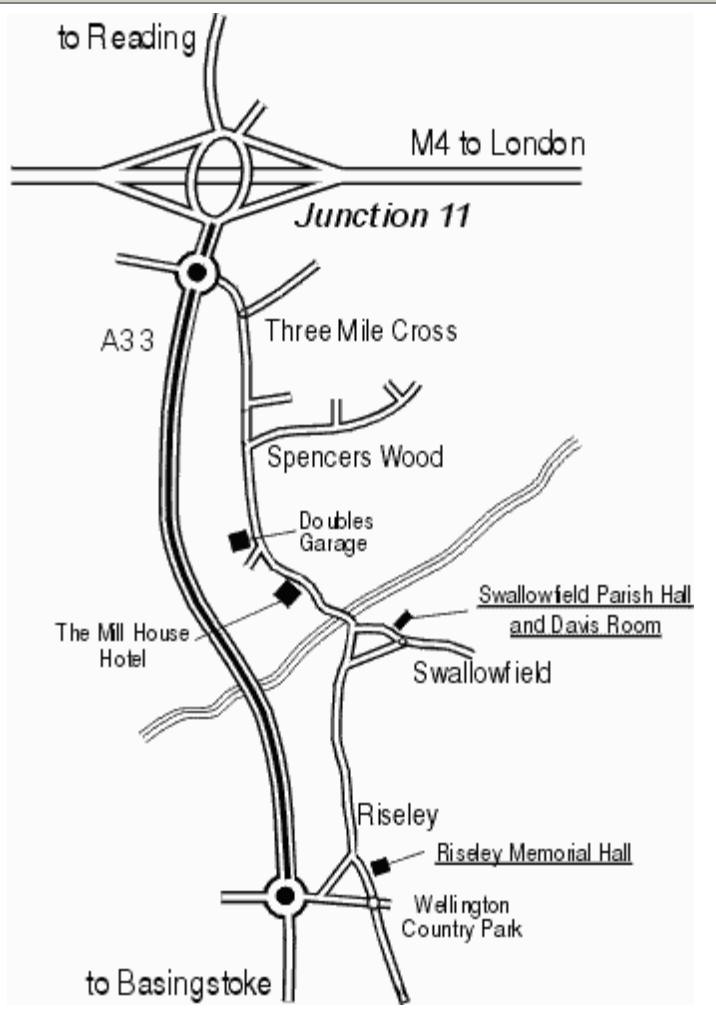

### Swallowfield Parish Hall and Davies Room

(Swallowfield Street, RG7 1QX)

From junction 11 on the M4, take first exit off the first roundabout to Three Mile Cross and Spencers Wood (A3349). After about 2 miles, pass the Mill House Hotel and immediately turn left, signposted Swallowfield ¼ m. The Hall is on the left, just before the mini roundabout and War Memorial.
